The Top 10 Basics of the Special Education Process

If you are a parent or professional beginning your journey through the special education process in North Dakota, this workshop is for you. You will learn the basic steps of the special education process from referral to the annual review of the student's individualized education program (IEP).



The Why, What, and How of the Special Education Evaluation Process

This two-part workshop answers many of the key questions often asked about the North Dakota special education evaluation process. Part 1 is designed to help you understand why a special education evaluation is completed and what the key requirements of a special education evaluation are. Part 2 reviews each of the key components of the evaluation process and several of the IDEA requirements that are embedded within each one.



Building an Individualized Education Program (IEP)

This two-part workshop helps parents and professionals the process and the framework of an appropriate and individualized education program. Part 1 summarizes IEP timelines, the qualifications and responsibilities of required IEP team members, and guidance on building and maintaining a strong partnership between all IEP team members. Part 2 provides an overview of the main purposes of the IEP planning process, including a decision making framework comprised of the key IEP components included in the North Dakota IEP process.



Creating Stronger Partnerships through Dispute Resolution

This workshop provides a review of the importance of positive and productive communication skills in building strong partnerships, presenting an overview of each of the formal dispute resolution options available through the IDEA, with a focus on the benefits of each option and the process to request the dispute resolution option in ND.
